1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Sailing Committee of the Sebago Canoe Club, Brooklyn, NY.

2. LANGUAGE

The official language of this regatta will be English.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Regatta is open to Laser sailors (Standard, Radial, 4.7), Sunfish sailors, Vanguard 15 sailors, 420 sailors.

4. RISK

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. (See RRS rule 4). The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1. Saturday May 12, 2012:

12 pm (noon)- Skippers' Meeting.

12:45 pm - First Warning Signal, races to follow.

Water and Snacks available on the water

4:15 pm - Return to Clubhouse and Debrief

4:45-6:45 pm - Pizza/Refreshments and Scoring announced

- 5.2 Six (6) races are scheduled for this event. The number of races will be adjusted by the race committee to accommodate weather conditions.

- 5.3 No warning signal will be made after 4 pm.

6. FEES

- 6.1 Required Fees (checks should be made payable to Sebago Canoe Club). The entry fee is \$15 USD for non-Sebago members.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8. COURSES & RACING AREA

- 8.1 The courses to be sailed will be one of the following Windward-Leeward-Windward, Windward-Leeward, Triangle-Windward-Leeward-Windward or Triangle-Windward-Leeward or may be changed as deemed appropriate by the PRO by verbal announcement.

- 8.2 The racing area will be Jamaica Bay in Gateway National Recreational Park, Brooklyn, NY

9. SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4, will be used except as modified in the SI.

- 9.2 Six races are scheduled.

- 9.3 When five or more races are completed a competitor may discard his/her worst score.
