1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
The organizing authority is the Sailing Committee of the Sebago Canoe Club, Brooklyn, NY.

2. ENTRIES

Entrees will be composed of Lasers (Full, Radial, 4.7) and Sunfish (race and recreational rigs, and any participating dinghy class with two or more boats of the same class that can safely launch from the Sebago dock or join the racing fleet on Jamaica Bay under the guidelines stated in the NOR and SI for this event.

3. FEES

Non-Sebago members may compete by paying a \$15 registration fee.

4. SCHEDULE

Sept. 21, 2019

11:00 am - Skippers' Meeting

12:00 pm - Warning Signal, race to follow

Awards, Casual Dinner (*and this year a member Birthday celebration following the race!*)

5. RISK

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. (See RRS rule 4). The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

At the discretion of the PRO this race may be canceled for winds over 20 mph or for any reason where the PRO feels that the back-up/rescue boat(s) cannot safely assist the sailing fleet.

However and additionally, *due to SCC's limited powerboat support*, any member of the RC or Sebago Canoe Club Sailing Committee may terminate any sailor's participation and mandate that they return to shore for not following the procedures, regulations or for any safety reason. The sailor must comply and retire from the days sailing.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7. COURSES & RACING AREA

The cruising course of 6-10 miles will be outlined at the Skippers Meeting the day of the race.

The racing area will be Jamaica Bay in Gateway National Recreational Park, Brooklyn, NY
