1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Sailing Committee of the Sebago Canoe Club, Brooklyn, NY.

2. LANGUAGE

The official language of this regatta will be English.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

There will be an "Open" fleet consisting of all Laser (Fulls and Radials) and Sunfish (both race and recreational rigs). Other dinghy classes are welcome to compete. Two or more boats of the same type will constitute a class.

4. RISK

- 4.1 At the discretion of the PRO this race may be canceled for winds over 20 mph or for any reason where the PRO feels that the back-up/rescue boats cannot safely assist the sailing fleet.
- 4.2 Upon the decision to hold the race, it is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. (See RRS rule 4). The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on shore activities before, during, and after the regatta. Additionally, due to SCC's limited powerboat support any member of the RC or Sebago Canoe Club Sailing Committee may request that a boat return to the dock for not following the procedures and regulations and/or the RC may terminate any sailor's participation and mandate that they return to shore – the sailor must comply.

5. SCHEDULE

Race Date: Sept. 15, 2018

11:00 am - Skippers' Meeting

12:00 pm - Warning Signal, race to follow

Casual dinner to follow the Race.

6. FEES

- 6.1 Required Fees for non-Sebago members (checks should be made payable to Sebago Canoe Club): The entry fee is \$20.
